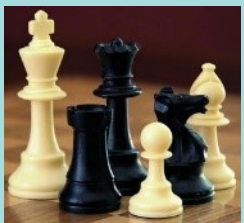

Fanwood Library Improvement Project (FLIP) update

As a result of the recent petition drive, the borough council officially recognized the need for the building project with a resolution.

Work continues to refine the design, and the Fanwood council has encouraged library trustees to explore both public and private funding methods, and we are especially excited to learn that our legislators drafted a bill that would match the borough's funding 1 to 1. This bill would be a \$125M bond issue that the public will vote on as a

referendum in this November's election. To show their support at this crucial time, library trustees will be sending our representatives a letter.
