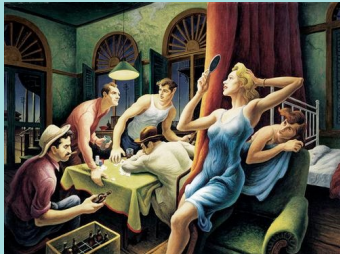

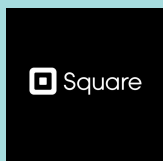

UPDATE: Fanwood Library Improvement Project (FLIP)

FLIP continues to gain momentum as the project architect refines the design. The borough council recently passed a [resolution](#) in support of the project and authorized the library board to be raising funds. The board is currently working to form a library foundation with this short-term fundraising goal and more long-term development goals.

Be sure to voice your support to your legislators for the NJ Library Construction Bond Act (A222/S2171), which would provide matching funds and significantly reduce the financial impact of the library improvement project on Fanwood taxpayers.
